## BA launches new BowlsLink app for iOS and Android

Bowls Australia has transitioned the name and brand identity of its flagship mobile application from "BowlsNow" to "BowlsLink".

The transition will be accompanied by some major feature upgrades based on user feedback, designed to improve mobile user experience and engagement.

The key improvements included in the rebranding of the application are:

### Member Login and Sign-up via app to Profile

All new member sign-up functions and member login will be introduced to the app, giving people the ability access and update their own personal information, pay for memberships, view digital membership and certification cards, and directly enter and pay for competitions.

#### **Enter a Competition via mobile**

Replicating a simplified version of the desktop competition entry, the BowlsLink App will allow members to easily and effortlessly find, register and pay for competitions with their mobiles.

The find a competition feature also allows members to use filters to narrow down the list of the competitions to their state, region or club, as well as within specific dates and format.

#### **Membership and Certification Digital Cards**

Members will now receive a digital membership card, with coaches and officials also able to access their certification cards via their member profile in the app.

These digital cards will have customised styling based on the primary colours of clubs and defined colours of each certification.

The cards will display all key information, including expiry dates, certification types, STA affiliation and history of previous memberships and certifications.

If you are a registered member of a bowls club, you will already have a BowlsLink account and login, and won't be required to sign up to the app.

Bowls Australia BowlsLink staff, STA staff and your club manager or secretary can assist if people have trouble logging in.

To download the BowlsLink App, search for 'BowlsLink' in the App Store for iOS devices and Google Play Store for Android devices.

For anyone who already has the BowlsLink App, make sure you check for the latest version.

Remember: BowlsLink requires an email address for a BowlsLink account to enter competitions and represent your club. If you don't have a BowlsLink account, see Frank or Dave and they will do it for you.

## *Umpire's* BOWLED GAME ADVICE

Our regular Umpire (Rod Kleinschmidt) is holidaying overseas, so Wests Tiger's "second official" has some quick tips on marking singles games in 2026.

- \* WHERE TO STAND: A marker must stand approximately two metres behind and one metre to the side at all times. Choose left or right and maintain that side of the rink, both up and down.
- \* ANSWER QUESTIONS: When asked "What is the situation?" the marker is free to give a short description of the head such as which player has the shot, where it is and even an indication of the second shot and position etc. If asked a question, answer promptly and succinctly and provide info on only what was asked.
- \* STAY CLOSE: When queried about the head, remember that if you need to take more than three steps to provide an answer, then you're standing too far away.
- \* REMAIN ON THE GREEN: A marker must NEVER leave the green. Stand off to one side but don't leave the rink or the playing surface.
- PROTECT OTHER RINKS: Be prepared to protect adjacent games when a drive is imminent. Stop or move bowls quickly if they look like disturbing a head on an nearby rink.
- \* COMING TO THE HEAD: Players may approach the head after their third or fourth bowls. At any other time they need to seek permission from their opponent and marker.
- \* DON'T FORGET: Write the score on the card whilst walking to place the jack and change the scoreboard between ends.
- KEEP THINGS MOVING: Don't be the one guilty of slowing down or interfering with the game. Don't be obvious and allow play to flow smoothly.

Marking is not boring and a good marker is an important asset for any club. Be a positive club member, lend a hand and be available when required. Thanks for reading - *If Needed*.
